 - Old Trail (Creekside) to Jarmans Gap
 - Connector Trail to Cory Farms (Route 250)

Preserve existing multi-use trails and promote access for passive recreational activities

- Completed regular mowing (County resources) and pruning
- Installed directional trail signs
- Built and delivered 5 benches
- Built a major bridge linking Crozet Park to the Connector Trail
- Improved Beaver Creek stream crossings
- Inventoried and maintained all equipment
